The winning team receives the SUW Traveling Trophy, championship banner and the Commissioners' Trophy that will stay with the team!


Awards are also presented to top performers in each competition and overall passing, strength, and speed & agility team champs.







- Team limit unlimited (All players in the football team can be included.)
- 2. Event Limit 5 participants constitute a team.
- 3. Participating High Schools may have two teams of 5.
- 4. Time will start equally for all events with an official starter.
- 5. Each event will be a duration of 5 minutes with 1 minute warning whistle at the 4 minute mark for all timed events.
- 6. There will be 3 minutes in between each event with a 1 warning whistle prior to the start of the next event.
- 7. Scoring will be on a point system based on the total number of teams entered in the event.
- 8. In the event of a tie for first, second, or third place, there will be a sudden death elimination round with the losing team taking the lower standing.
