Breakfast & H.O.P.E.

On Friday, September 5, Schuylkill United Way officially launched their 2026 Campaign, and also began celebrating their 90th year of service in the county. Because the money raised funds some of the services and programs of their 15 Partner Agencies in 2026, the SUW Board of Directors kept with the theme, announcing the campaign goal of \$1,190,000.

A special video of photos spanning from 1936 to present was shown to the record setting 150 attendees, as was this year's campaign video featuring all of our Partner Agencies

SUW Board President, John Gleisner recognized the **decades of dedication held by the Chief Professional Officers of SUW Partner Agencies**. Plaques were given to six executive directors marking over 20 years in their position. Hitting 30 years in 2025 were Mr. Doug Allen of Big Impact Group of Schuylkill County, Ms. Carolyn Bazik of Schuylkill Wellness Services, and Mr. Peter Keitsock of Avenues (formerly United Cerebral Palsy). Awards were also given to Ms. Mary Ann Devlin of Child Development, Inc. with 22 years, Ms. Samantha Gibbons of Tamaqua Area Meals on Wheels with 24 years, and Ms. Sharon Kimmel of the Schuylkill County Society for Pediatric Orthopedics with 26 years.

"Food is love!" declared SUW 2026 Campaign Chair Mr. Chris Dende as he announced a new initiative involving local restaurants and dining establishments. The first "**United We Dine Week**" ran September 5 - 14 and included 17 locations across Schuylkill County. The entity that brings in the most donations will be recognized at our annual Appreciation Breakfast on Friday, November 14 at St. Nick's Hall in Primrose.

Also happening at our annual Appreciation Breakfast will be the drawing of winners for the campaign prizes. A total of \$36,100 in prizes are generously donated by local businesses to support the work of SUW and its Partner Agencies.

SUW Executive Director, Kelly K. Malone stated, "It's great to be able to look back, and reminisce, but we are also very much about looking forward." She encouraged everyone to have their pledge cards and prize stubs to the SUW office by Noon on Wednesday, November 12th in order to be eligible for the drawing and chance to win the grand prize – a 2025 Chevrolet Trailblazer AWD LS valued at \$28,000!


A beautiful day supporting SUW on the golf course!
